Pageant Fees

This year we are taking a new approach to pageant fees. We've created a new payment portal on our website. All you have to do is fill out the form outlining what you'd like to pay for and our office will send an invoice to you directly. These invoices allow you to pay online using any credit card, debit card, or bank account as well as save a payment method to use later. If you or any of your sponsors plan to pay by check please ensure they are made out to Landry Productions LLC. Any checks made out incorrectly will be returned. In August all of our contestants will receive a statement showing all of their payments so that you can review and send any updates, changes, or corrections to our office. Friday, September 3rd is the deadline to pay entry fee and title fee balances or make changes to your account. After this date you will only be able to purchase tickets or add optional entries.

Contestant Bio

The Contestant Bio gives our judges a glimpse of your background and personality. Bios are required for all contestants in the National Pageant whether they are competing for the National Queens Competition or in the National Victory Competition. The Contestant Bio does not receive a score and is not a factor in the interview score. Although the bio is required, it is important to know that judges have discretion in their line of questioning and they may choose to create questions from the bio or use general questions. Important Notes

- Guests of the pageant receive a discounted rate beginning at \$129+tax per night
- Prices vary based on the number of people in your party
- On site parking is available for a discounted rate of \$10 per day
- The deadline for booking discounted rooms is September 7, 2021
- After the deadline, the hotel is not obligated to honor this rate
- Discounted rooms are limited so we recommend booking as soon as possible
- The hotel typically offers a shuttle to/from Hartsfield-Jackson airport and to nearby public transportation, however, this service may change depending on local covid-19 policies. We will monitor this and notify contestants as we get closer to Nationals
- At this time masks are required inside the hotel except when in your room or eating.
- The pageant is required to follow any guidelines that Hilton Atlanta Airport and Hilton Corporate have in place during the week of the pageant.
- We will continue to monitor the policies and update contestants regularly.

Optional Awards

Talent

Contestants will have 2 minutes on stage to present a talent of their choice. Judges will be looking for presence, entertainment value, confidence, and poise under pressure. The 2 minute time is enforced. If your music does not stop at the 2 minute mark it will be faded out. Should you continue to perform after the time limit, you will receive point deductions with the amount of points decided at the judge's discretion. A winner will be selected in each of the following groups: Princess, Sweetheart, Preteen, Junior Teen, Teen, and Coed. Our three Ms Divisions will be combined with one winner selected. Makeup and hand held props are allowed in all ages. Our National Talent winners will take home a commemorative plaque, the National Optional crown and banner, and a \$300 cash prize. Scores in the Talent Competition can be used toward your National Victory scores. Use the link below to submit your talent music. All talent contestants must complete the online talent form by the end of Pageant Check In on Thursday, October 7th.

Fashion

Contestants will model their outfit in a walking pattern of their choice. Outfits for this competition should be unique ensembles that you would only wear for a special event or this type of competition. Off the rack, street wear, sportswear, and casual outfits should be used for the Model competition. Our judges will be looking for personality, confidence, and age appropriate styling. A winner will be selected in each of the following groups: Princess, Sweetheart, Preteen, Junior Teen, Teen, and Coed. Our three Ms Divisions will be combined with one winner selected. Makeup is allowed in all ages. Our National Fashion winners will take home a commemorative plaque, the National Optional crown and banner, and a \$300 cash prize. Scores in the Fashion Competition can be used toward your National Victory Scores.

Optional Awards

Speech

Contestants will have up to 2 minutes to present a speech of their choice. The maximum time is enforced and anyone going over time will receive deductions with judges having discretion over the amount of points. All speeches must be performed by memory without notes, props, or any presentation materials. A copy of your speech will be sent to the emcee in case you need assistance during your performance. Judges will be looking for professionalism, content, and a confident delivery. A winner will be selected in each of the following groups: Princess, Sweetheart, Preteen, Junior Teen, Teen, and Coed. Our three Ms Divisions will be combined with one winner selected. Makeup is allowed in all ages. Our National Speech winners will take home a commemorative plaque, the National Optional crown and banner, and a \$300 cash prize. Scores in the Speech Competition can be used toward your National Victory scores. All contestants entered must fill out the Speech Form by the end of Pageant Check In on Thursday, October 7th

Actress

This year our Actress competition will take on a new format. Contestants will be performing in a live audition setting and will have 90 seconds to perform a commercial, scene, or monologue of their choice. Entries will be performed in a separate space and recorded for our judges to review. Judges will be looking for entertainment value, performance quality, and poise. A winner will be selected in each of the following groups: Princess, Sweetheart, Preteen, Junior Teen, Teen, and Coed. Our three Ms Divisions will be combined with one winner selected. Makeup is allowed in all ages. Our National Actress winners will take home a commemorative plaque, the National Optional crown and banner, and a \$300 cash prize. Scores from the Actress Competition can be used toward your National Victory scores.

Optional Awards

Photogenic

Our photogenic competition is open to all contestants who want to showcase their eye catching photos. Judges will be looking for age appropriate and natural styling, complimentary grooming, and overall photo quality and presentation. Makeup is allowed in all ages. A winner will be selected in each of the following groups: Princess, Sweetheart, Preteen, Junior Teen, Teen, and Coed. Our three Ms Divisions will be combined with one winner selected. Our National Photogenic winners will take home a commemorative plaque, the national optional crown and banner, and a \$300 cash prize. Scores in the photogenic competition cannot be used toward your National Victory scores. All photogenic entries must submit the Photogenic Form by end of Pageant Check In on Thursday, October 7th.

Contestants will model their outfit in a walking pattern of their choice. Outfits for this competition should be off the rack, street wear, sportswear, and casual outfits. Our judges will be looking for personality, confidence, and age appropriate styling. A winner will be selected in each of the following groups: Princess, Sweetheart, Preteen, Junior Teen, Teen, and Coed. Our three Ms Divisions will be combined with one winner selected. Makeup is allowed in all ages. Our National Model winners will take home a commemorative plaque, the national optional crown and banner, and a \$300 cash prize. Scores in the Model competition can be used toward your National Victory scores.


Preliminary Awards

In each show group we'll recognize the contestant with the highest score in Eveningwear, Personal Appearance & Introduction, and Interview. All contestants are eligible for these awards and there is no charge to enter. Age divisions will be combined in the following way: Princess & Sweetheart, Preteen & Junior Teen, Teen & Coed, Ms Divisions. Winners will be announced during our final pageant and will receive a commemorative plaque.

People's Choice Award

We're excited to partner with The Pageant Planet for this year's People's Choice Competition! Voting will take place on the Pageant Planet website and will close on October 10th. Age divisions will be combined in the following way: Princess & Sweetheart, Preteen & Junior Teen, Teen & Coed, Ms Divisions. The contestant with the highest number of votes in each show group will take home a banner, commemorative plaque, and cash prize.


Eveningwear Pattern



Contestants will enter from the back-center of the stage and pause for a moment before moving to mark number 2 where they will pose again. After posing at mark number 2 contestants will walk toward center stage. After stopping at mark number 3, contestants will complete a circle of the runway and pause briefly again at mark 3. Contestants will have a final look on mark number 4 before heading to the back and exiting at mark number 5. Please note the following:

- Posing, such as placing a hand on your hip, is allowed but should not be excessive and not distracting
- holding or picking up your gown is strongly discouraged
- no makeup is allowed on any contestants in the Princess, Sweetheart, or Preteen Age Divisions
- all contestants should follow the walking pattern
- if needed, contestants may use a pivot turn, half turn, or take an extra few steps to move from their marks
- Any changes to this walking pattern will be sent out in advance

Interview Room



Contestants will enter the room and walk to their mark. Once in place they will perform their introduction and one full turn. Princess contestants may choose from a pivot turn or circle turn. All other divisions will do a pivot turn. After returning to face the judges, our moderator will escort the contestant out of the room. Once all of the contestants in the interview group have performed their introduction, the group will be brought in to be seated for the interviews. Please note the following:

- Interviews will be one on one in a "round robin" / rotation style
- Introductions have a maximum time limit of 30 seconds
- Contestants in the princess division will enter the room in small groups along with a staff member for introduction and will sit for interview after the last introduction in their small group
- All other divisions will enter one at a time for introduction and will come back with their small group to begin their interview
- no makeup is allowed on any contestants in the Princess, Sweetheart, or Preteen age divisions
- Any changes to this format will be sent out in advance
