This is certainly the case when talking about Power's '68-'69 Two Mile Relay team of Andy Walsh, Tony Colon, Pete Lovett and John Lovett. Each of them exceptional individual runners, they were the most impressive when competing as a group. This was never more evident than their 1969 Penn Relays record setting two-mile relay victory, a record that stood for the next 21 years. They were inducted into the Penn Relays Hall of Fame in 1995.
