After a sluggish start, in which the team only won four of its first seven games. The Panthers won their final 13 regular season games to finish with a 17 - 3 record. They continued their winning streak throughout the Bronx-Manhattan Championship and the City Championship beating Tolentine and Rice twice and St Francis Prep and Stepinac once.

Power's leading scorer was Larry Petty with 19 points and 12 rebounds. Capt Sean Canning was the second leading scorer with 13 points and lead the team in assists. Eddie Moss was the other starting backcourt man and scored 19 points against Tolentine. Tony DeMichele had a strong finish and ended up with a 10 point average. The fifth starting spot was shuffled around all year between Carlton Neverson, Robert Rogers and Robert Simak
