Zion's Financial Statement 2020

2020 was a year that presented Zion with unanticipated challenges. Financial performance remained remarkably solid. Pledged and unpledged giving and special offerings were 5% lower than 2019, but considering that there were few services and "plate" collections this is remarkable. The Finance team and Council want to thank all the faithful givers that made this year a time when we could support our members and the community at large.

In addition, we have taken on the challenge of raising capital funds for Pave the Way – the parking lot. Again, Zion's faithful givers are rising to that challenge.

Just a note: Miscellaneous income in 2020 reflects the \$41,000 in PPP funds which we used according to the guidelines, hence this loan was forgiven. We also sent money to the Food Shelf, the Refuge and CLACA, supporting local agencies.

As you look at 2020 expenses the lower costs we have associated with normal business are reduced. Overall, there was a 33% reduction in operating costs, most in payroll, office, utilities and all the many of the costs we incur simply by using our building. (see chart on next page)

In summary, thank you all for your faithful giving. We are looking forward to when we can use our resources to greet each other, feed the hungry, and encourage our youth in person. Until then....thank you!


