

The Nevada Department of Transportation is evaluating long-term solutions to address aging infrastructure, improve safety, and relieve congestion on Interstate 515 between Rancho Drive and Mojave Road. In compliance with the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA), preliminary alternatives have been developed and environmental studies are underway.

Project Location



Proposed Improvements

- > Remove existing 1.6-mile viaduct (bridge) and place freeway on embankment or recess freeway
- > Fix ramp spacing with ramp braiding between I-515 and I-15
- > Add freeway capacity (from 3 lanes plus auxiliary lane to 4 lanes, HOV lane, and auxiliary lane)
- > New High Occupancy Vehicle (HOV) interchanges at City Parkway and Maryland Parkway
- > Bike/pedestrian mobility improvements adjacent to and across the freeway
