Thank you for attending the Nevada Department of Transportation's (NDOT) South Virginia Street Safety Management Plan (SMP) public meeting. This meeting is to discuss safety challenges and potential solutions along South Virginia Street between Patriot Boulevard and Mt. Rose Highway. Your input and feedback are important to us as we continue to study the corridor.

A SMP is a transportation analysis that focuses on traffic safety for all road users. These studies are consistent with the Nevada Strategic Highway Safety Plan's goals of eliminating fatalities and serious injuries on Nevada's roadways.

We want feedback from the community on short-term, mid-term, and long-term solutions to improve South Virginia Street. Following the conclusion of the SMP, NDOT will work with its partners, including RTC Washoe and the City of Reno, to secure funding and implement these improvements.

There are many opportunities to provide your input. We have a court reporter available to take direct comments from you; she will also be recording the question-and-answer period after the presentation.
