LIAISON PROGRAM



The WSA hosts the only Legislative Liaison program in the country. We invite each of our member institutions to send a representative of their student association to Olympia each year to lobby our state representatives and work directly on legislation. The WSA offers intensive trainings, an office space located a few blocks from the capital, communications strategy and coordination, higher education policy expertise, and daily coordination and support for the Legislative Liaisons. By using this model, our association has passed hundreds of bills over the last few decades, including the creation of the Washington College Grant, which is nationally recognized as the most comprehensive and equitable student financial aid program in the country.

In addition to passing quality legislation, our Legislative Liaison program gives students real life experience working in public policy that most people are not exposed to until they are well into their careers. This experience trains our student advocates for successful careers in nonprofit management, public relations, as legislative assistants, consultants, lawyers, public policy experts, lobbyists, and as legislators themselves.
