We are writing to share the results of the Church Conference meeting held on July 17, during which a vote was taken regarding the future of our church parsonage.

We are pleased to report that the motion to sell the parsonage passed unanimously. The final vote count was as follows:

- 30 votes in absentia (Yes)
- 28 votes in person (Yes)
  - 0 abstentions
  - 0 votes against

This clear and unified decision reflects the thoughtful consideration and prayerful discernment of our congregation. We are deeply grateful to everyone who participated—whether by attending in person or by submitting your vote in absentia. Your engagement in this important matter is a testament to the strength and unity of our church community.
