Home Delivered Meals ...

for homebound seniors. All meals are prepared daily in the Meals on Wheels, Etc. kitchen. Each meal

provides one-third of the Recommended Daily Allowance (RDA) and are approved by a licensed nutritionist.


Meighborhood Dining ...


Transportation ...

Home Improvements ...

With the help of volunteers, local businesses, churches and civic groups we provide home repairs and chore services, including minor repairs and the installation of safety features.

Homemaking ...

Our Homemaking service covers general housekeeping and laundry. This service is offered twice a month for two hours to homebound seniors.
