Sherry Fincher, Executive Director Announces Retirement

Sherry Fincher joined Meals on Wheels, Etc. in March, 1992 as Assistant Director and in 1994 was promoted to Executive Director of the organization. Sherry has been instrumental in developing many partnerships with local businesses, civic groups, church groups and individuals over the years.

In December, 2004, Sherry led the effort with the opening of the current office building as the organization was able to celebrate the brand-new Meals on Wheels kitchen.

In 2007, many milestones were achieved as both the Homemaker and Weatherization Programs were added to the list of programs and services being offered to Seminole County seniors. By the end of the year, Top Hat Catering Services was born. The catering service also provided the organization the ability to earn additional revenue to support the many programs. All proceeds from catering is funded back to Meals on Wheels, Etc.

With each year, the demand for services has increased and the organization continues to step up to the challenges with Sherry leading the way. Last year, in 2020, during the national pandemic, 129,206 meals were delivered to 440 clients and 53,689 meals were served to 195 neighborhood dining clients.

Sherry's contributions to the organization have been countless and her love and commitment for the organization, clients, volunteers, donors, staff and supporters is clearly evident.

Please join us in wishing Sherry the best as she closes one chapter and opens another. Sherry has downsized her homestead and plans to remain in the local area. Some of her retirement plans include more tennis and golf time, and maybe discovering a new passion.
