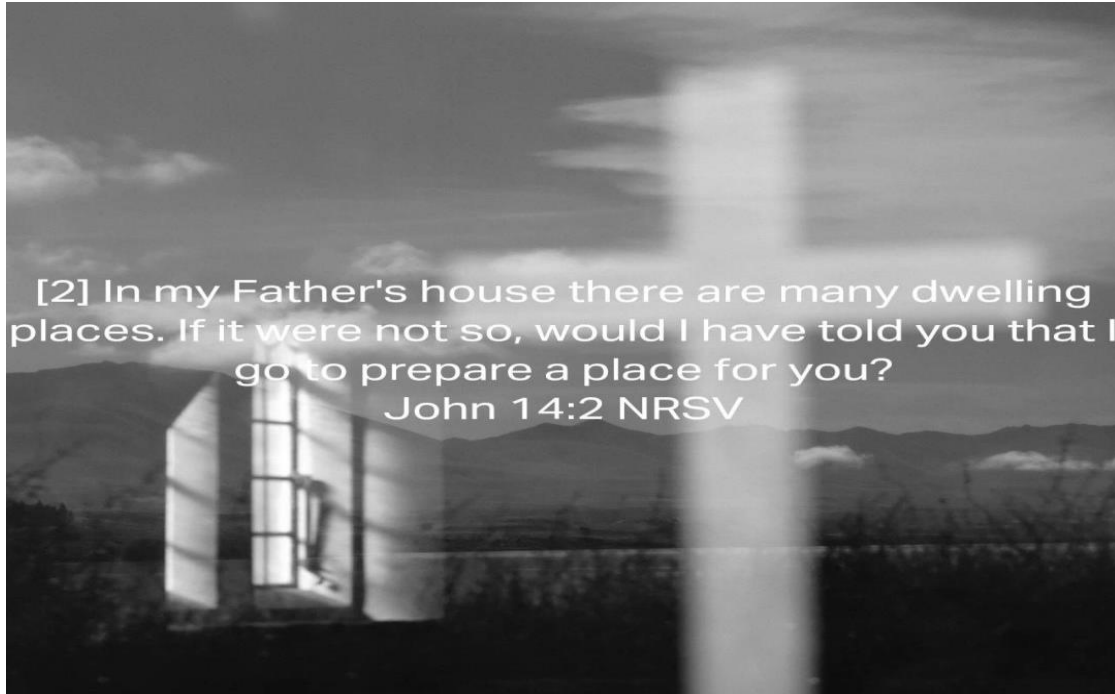

Finding Meaning Through Tragedy

Have you ever experienced gut wrenching grief or trauma? Unfortunately, many people have been directly affected by loss and trauma or have known someone who has. Tragic loss can lead a person to feel defeated or to feel assured that God is with them in their suffering. As Christians, we know that Jesus sacrificed his life to save his people, but at the time of His death, Mary and the disciples may have looked at Jesus' death as a tragic ending initially until they witnessed his resurrection and were reassured that His promise of life everlasting is true.

Sometimes we can be bombarded through media of multiple types of tragic events and become overwhelmed or helpless to know what to do. In a lifetime, we may experience news of earthquakes, hurricanes, mud slides, tsunamis, mass shootings, deaths by drunk drivers, fatal car

crashes, death by war or genocide and tragic loss related to domestic violence. Well, you get the grim idea. What is important to remember is that people have found amazing ways to manage the impact of such events that were out of their control. I believe it's a God thing.

Some examples of the wonderful responses that have occurred after tragic loss are the creation of charitable organizations, foundations, scholarships and disaster response teams by people who may have been directly or indirectly impacted by tragedy. Some of these include the COPE Foundation, Compassionate Friends, the National Alliance for Children's Grief and OUR HOUSE which all offer grief and healing support services. Another organization CARE is the largest private international humanitarian nonprofit that is committed to helping families in poor communities improve their lives and achieve lasting victories over poverty. CARE was found in 1945 to provide relief to survivors of World War II. Team Rubicon was established by Marine Corps veteran, Jake Wood, in 2010 after a 7.0 earthquake devastated Haiti. He along with 6 others jumped into action with compassion to help thousands of survivors. That organization has since grown exponentially.

There are other individuals that started benevolent causes after terrible tragedies. Triumph Over Tragedy Foundation was created by Reggie and Wesley Jones of Georgia some years after Wesley fell from a zip line in April 1987 and became paraplegic. This organization assists families who are dealing with catastrophic illness or life-changing injuries. David Schury established Tragedy to Triumph after he was burned over 30% of his body on April 13, 2000 while at his job when a damaged wire short circuited a 12,000 volt piece of equipment causing an explosion at a substation of Commonwealth Edison, the Chicago based electric company where Schury worked for 34 years.

The parents of the Sandy Hook Elementary School mass shooting victims established Sandy Hook Promise to lobby for gun control measures and greater safety in schools. Countless other families affected by loss related to subsequent school shootings have followed in the path of assisting families affected by these tragedies.

The family of Hannah Goman established the Hannah Goman Foundation and Safe Drive program in their Michigan city after Hannah was killed by a drunk driver. The program offered free transportation to individuals under the influence of a substance. Another foundation established by the notable John Travolta and his late wife Kelly Preston was named The Jett Travolta Foundation after their oldest son, Jett, who died of an apparent seizure at 16 years old. This foundation helps children with special needs.

I could name many other nonprofits that help people in various ways to get through tragedy, but the list is endless as people continue to find ways to develop meaning from suffering.

Remember that God will always be with us when we are suffering in any way just as He was with Jesus in the final hours. We Christians know that God will help us grow and develop a stronger bond with Him when we give compassionately to others to ease their pain and find meaning in our own suffering.
