for them. The power of thanksgiving is in the action. Here are 3 simple steps I learned from the FCA that can help us put thanksgiving into action:

- 1. Are you thankful? Would family, neighbors and friends say you have a heart of thankfulness? Why or why not?
- 2. List three people in your life who you are thankful for and why. Then, go and tell them.
- 3. What are the things that prevent you from expressing your thanks?

When we do this, we echo the words of the Psalmist in Psalm 100: A Psalm for giving thanks. Make a joyful noise to the Lord, all the earth! Serve the Lord with gladness! Come into his presence with singing! Know that the Lord, he is God! It is he who made us, and we are his; we are his people, and the sheep of his pasture. Enter his gates with thanksgiving, and his courts with praise! Give thanks to him; bless his name! For the Lord is good; his steadfast love endures forever, and his faithfulness to all generations.

Thank you, Lord, for always being there; for pathways steep and rough; not what You do, but who You are, will always be enough. Amen.
