## Community Lay Director's Letter

## Fourth Day

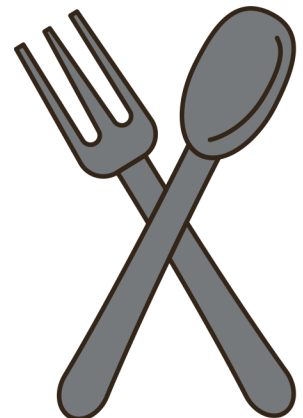
A Fourth Day (also known as Follow-Up) meeting will be held for you and your pilgrims at the time and location listed below. Your pilgrim will receive an orientation about Emmaus, The Dayspring Community, its leaders, gatherings, Reunion Groups and other important information not covered on the Walk. We will discuss sponsorship in great detail as continued sponsorship is the lifeblood of our community. A significant part of the meeting is dedicated to the support provided to your pilgrim on their Fourth Day experience following their Walk. As a sponsor, you are responsible for bringing your pilgrim to this meeting. There will be an opportunity to reunite with other pilgrims at their table. All Pilgrims will be invited to attend this follow-up meeting at closing on Saturday afternoon so you, as a sponsor, should view the follow-up as a part of the walk and make every effort to have your Pilgrim attend. Sponsors should assist in providing or retaining childcare if needed, because childcare is not provided at Fourth Day. Team members of the current walks and board members will be present along with any other Emmaus Community members who wish to welcome Dayspring's newest members. Just a reminder: Your continuing role of sponsorship after the Walk, includes bringing your pilgrim to the Fourth Day meeting, seeing that they are plugged into a Reunion Group, and bringing them to the next two gatherings.

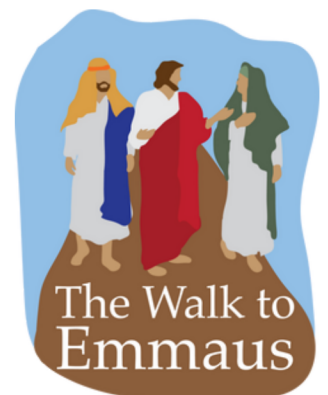

**What is a Reunion Group?** The Emmaus group reunion is a small accountability group of two to 12 persons who have usually participated in the three-day Walk to Emmaus and who want to continue their pursuit of a life lived wholly in the grace of God. These small follow-up groups help pilgrims translate the message conveyed on the Walk to Emmaus weekend into a daily walk with Christ. With the regular support of a few faithful friends, the gift of God's love in Jesus Christ becomes a lifestyle of Christian discipleship through the threefold discipline of piety, study, and action. Group reunions meet at regular times, usually weekly for an hour. The meeting consists of persons' sharing the stories of their walk with Christ during the past week. Members listen to one another, celebrate the grace of God in each person's life, and reinforce each one's core commitment to living in union with Christ in all facets of daily life. Members express that reinforcement through gentle accountability, encouragement, and support of one's stated discipline and plans. *Excerpted from The Group Reunion by Stephen D. Bryant.
