Community Spiritual Director's letter

Greetings brothers and sisters in the Dayspring Emmaus Community,

A good friend of mine knows me and knows how many plates I try to keep spinning in the air at the same time. Upon learning that I was serving as Community Spiritual Director he asked me, "Why on Earth would you say yes to this position?" The short answer for me was simply, "How could I not!" The punctuation in the preceding sentence is correct. I wasn't asking my friend a question with another question! I was making the statement – "How could I not!"

I attended Dayspring Emmaus Walk 86 and I could fill up this entire newsletter with what that weekend meant to me and the impact it had on me, but I don't want to do that. I'd rather tell you the story of a closing I attended. I don't remember who the lay director was, nor the walk number or very many other details about it. I do remember one of the pilgrims was a pastor. He is the pastor of a pretty large church that does very well. Some of his walk brothers were on that walk as residents of transition housing facility and had not long prior to that walk been living at Branchville Correctional Facility. As the pastor answered the two questions "What did the walk mean to me?" And "What am I going to do with it?" It was clear God showed up and met him where he was.

Then those walk brothers of his, who in former lives had been incarcerated, answered the same two questions and I could not contain the emotions as it became clear to me: When we show up ready, it doesn't matter where we are, God shows up!

Luke 24: 31-32, 31 Then their eyes were opened and they recognized him, and he disappeared from their sight. 32 They asked each other, "Were not our hearts burning within us while he talked with us on the road and opened the Scriptures to us?"

Those friends, those disciples, asked each other a question that neither really answered. They returned to Jerusalem to tell the others.

"How could I not!" It's clear this Emmaus experience is a vessel God uses to show up and it's an honor to have been asked by Grant Belles to serve in this capacity and approved by your board to serve. This community, this board, these walks and these pilgrims remain in my prayers!

What is a Reunion Group? The Emmaus group reunion is a small accountability group of two to 12 persons who have usually participated in the three-day Walk to Emmaus and who want to continue their pursuit of a life lived wholly in the grace of God. These small follow-up groups help pilgrims translate the message conveyed on the Walk to Emmaus weekend into a daily walk with Christ. With the regular support of a few faithful friends, the gift of God's love in Jesus Christ becomes a lifestyle of Christian discipleship through the threefold discipline of piety, study, and action. Group reunions meet at regular times, usually weekly for an hour. The meeting consists of persons' sharing the stories of their walk with Christ during the past week. Members listen to one another, celebrate the grace of God in each person's life, and reinforce each one's core commitment to living in union with Christ in all facets of daily life. Members express that reinforcement through gentle accountability, encouragement, and support of one's stated discipline and plans. Excerpted from The Group Reunion by Stephen D. Bryant.
