Treasurer Report (Jerry)

- Circulated the report
- \$21,000 income; \$58,000 in the bank; \$7,000 earmarked for backboards
- \$4,300 from Riverhounds event

Fall Sports Update

Girls Volleyball (Lisa)

- Playoffs start the week of Oct 16th
- OC will host the finals (last weekend of October)
- Varsity black, JV black and JV Red will go to playoffs
- Wednesday, 10/11 is 8th grade recognition night. 7pm recognition ceremony, 7:30 scrimmage
- Looking for coaches for next year, will also need another coordinator after this season.
- Hoping to schedule the end of year party after all teams are finished with the playoffs.

Soccer (Amy, Kylie, Jackie)

- 3rd and 4th grade are preparing for the tournaments
- JV/Varsity – 6 games over the weekend and won them all
- Varsity 8th grade is in 2nd place
- Amy is working on the gift order
- There was a sportsmanship issue with one of the teams scoring 13 goals over another team. This game will not count towards playoffs. Coaches were reprimanded but not suspended. The rule is that no one is permitted to run up the score. Coaches must read the rules and all emails that are circulated.
- Jeremy stressed the importance of educating coaches and following the rules so that we don't get a reputation of poor sportsmanship.
- In soccer, they have this rule because there are no A & B divisions to keep the games balanced.

Cross Country (Keli)

- Gifted shorts are ordered
- Championships this weekend. Diocesan championship is next weekend.
- Approved for new uniforms for next year.

Cheerleading (Reena)

- All uniforms are ordered and most have been distributed
- Competitions dates
 - Saturday, February 17, 8am, at Ave Maria Academy
 - Saturday, March 9, 8am, at Archangel Gabriel
 - Saturday, March 23, 8am, at St. Therese of Lisieux (Diocesan Championship)

Basketball

- Discussed the possibility of a google doc to keep track of donations.
- Annie would like to attend all team parent meetings at the beginning of the season to explain the "ins and outs" of the concession stand.
- She is also trying to track the profits per game by asking volunteers to count the starting and ending amount in the concessions cash box. There are slips of paper to do this in the money box.

Fundraising

- **Sponsorship** (Matt / Jeremy) \$24,900 committed, >\$13,000 collected. Matt Wirtz is reaching out to collect.
- **Slides / Crocs** (Jeremy) \$350 profit, should be delivered around Oct 15th. Will then be sorted and distributed.
- **Magnets** (Amy) They are currently in the office, can we get some in the concession stand to sell? Erin will take them to concession for 8th grade recognition. Lanyards

also...they were \$6.50 each, can sell for \$8. Could also sell some extra rally towels in the concession stand.

Future Events

- **SHES 150 basketball** (Vicki) Vicki posed the question of whether we could incorporate an alumni game alongside the Christmas tournament? The tournament is Dec 26-30. Daily games run until about 8:30, so could have a starting time at 9pm, which seems a little rough, especially because the gym is usually a mess by then. Perhaps on Saturday, if the championship games end earlier, that could be an option. Matt will send out invitations for the tournament by the end of October.
- **Elks foul shooting contest - 11/25** (Jeremy) We are hosting this on behalf of the local Elks lodge out of Wilkins township. They need the gym 8am-1pm. Will be open to all of our students (might be 4th to 8th grade).

Open Discussion
