

It was pieced and quilted by Crystal Kotow-Sullivan who took up quilting during the Great Pause a few years ago. Her 89-year-old aunt, who has been quilting since she was 8, has been her teacher and guide. She is able to do the quilting on her aunt's long arm sewing machine.

The quilt measures 42" by 42" (100cm by 100cm). It is made of 100% cotton. The batting is also made of cotton. It is machine washable and can be put in the dryer.
