

Scholarship Report (2021)

Right now, in our Pre-Endowment fund, we have \$13,480.00 and, we have \$4,818.00 in our Scholarship fund

Silent Auction: Our silent auction raised over \$3,309.00.

More Good News: In December we will deposit our auction funds to the Scholarship Fund bringing that total to \$8,127.00. We will transfer \$6,627 from our scholarship fund to to our Preendowment fund bringing that total to \$20,107.00 which means that we will be able to begin offering both the endowed scholarship AND our annual scholarships in 2022.

Sent out 33 print newsletters to those with no computer access (9 legacy individuals)

Changed format of newsletter to connect more directly to the web page increase of "click through" rate indicates this was a successful move. Web page has increasingly more traffic

Issues

It takes a huge amount of resources (financial, time, and people) to mail out newsletters. Although we would like to continue this practice, without a dedicated individual to take on this task, we have no choice but to discontinue it.

Activities 2021 Presented by Bob Cox



- Focus on Leveraging Technology in order to stay connected through Covid
- GBCRA hosted 17 separate events including lectures, virtual world tours, food tastings, virtual theatre events and games days
- We provided support to 5 events offered by external providers
- There were a total of 315 individual registrations which translates to about 130 individual members
- GBCRA covered 100% of the cost for 13 events

 - Rebrand newsletter, and web page
 - Create and brand social media presence
 - Send event reminders the day of each event
 - Recruit someone to look after web and social media





- Voting
 - When fees are required to maintain voting membership status, fees that are paid by September 30th will apply to the current year and will entitle the member to vote in that year's Annual General Meeting.
 - Membership fees paid on or after October 1st will apply to the following calendar year and such members will be considered "unpaid members" in the current calendar year for AGM voting and other purposes.

New Retirees

The membership fee for new retirees will be waived for the year in which they retire. Anyone who retires on or after October 1st will have their membership fee waived for the following calendar year, although they will be considered to be a Voting Member at the Annual General Meeting in the year they retire.


