Recent Wastewater Overflow in Peninsula!

Charlotte Water's Rapid Response Crew recently responded to a wastewater overflow near 17801 Spinnakers Reach Drive in Cornelius. An estimated 400 gallons (out of 630 gallons) reached Lake Norman. Construction damage caused the overflow.

Crews may run hydrants to flush the area, lightly apply lime to sanitize, and/or return to investigate other pipes.



How You Can Help:

- Toss in the trash: paper towels, wipes, hair, cotton swabs, feminine products, dental floss, coffee grounds, and excess food.
- Toss in the toilet: only toilet paper.
- Drain in the sink: soap suds, small amounts of foods from plate, and liquids.
- Take to a full-service recycling center: used and expired oils and grease.
