Recent Wastewater Overflow in Peninsula!

Charlotte Water's Rapid Response Crew responded to a wastewater overflow near 19632 Meta Road in Cornelius. An estimated 600 gallons reached Lake Norman. Most homes along the lakes are served by low pressure sewer systems that convey waste to a gravity fed sewer to our wastewater treatment plants. A contractor accidentally damaged a low pressure wastewater pipe causing the overflow.

Crews may run hydrants to flush the area, lightly apply lime to sanitize, and/or return to investigate other pipes.



How You Can Help:

- Toss in the trash: paper towels, wipes, hair, cotton swabs, feminine products, dental floss, coffee grounds, and excess food.
- Toss in the toilet: only toilet paper.
- Drain in the sink: soap suds, small amounts of foods from plate, and liquids.
- Take to a full-service recycling center: used and expired oils and grease.
