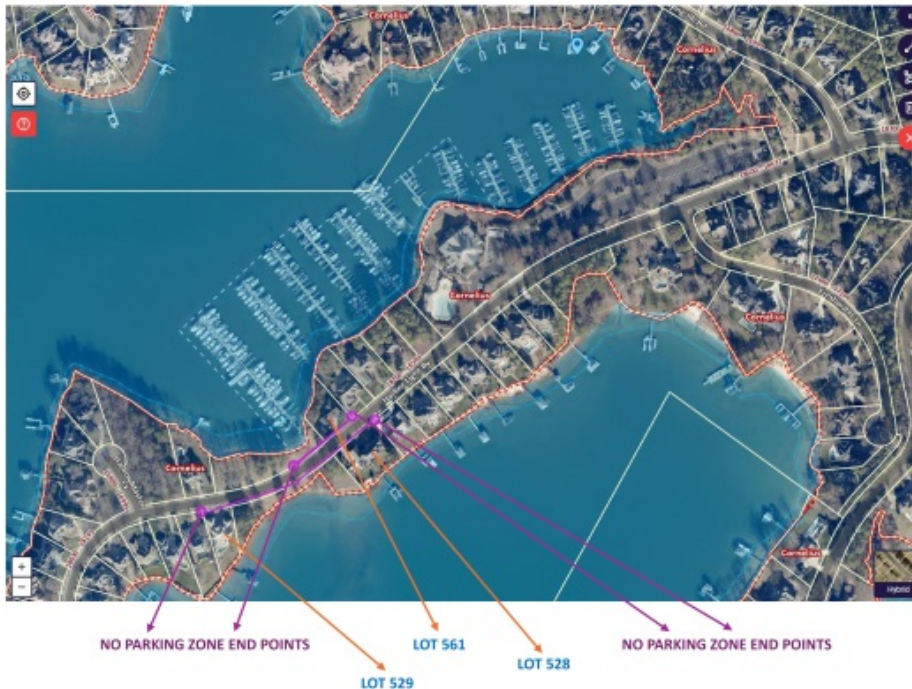

No Parking Zone

HARBOR LIGHT BOULEVARD NO-PARKING ZONE REVISED (09/05/2024)



For years, the Town of Cornelius and the Peninsula Property Owners Association Board have struggled with where to place "No Parking" signs on Harbor Light Boulevard. Neighbors who live on the street-- especially those near the Safe Harbor Peninsula Yacht Club-- complained about cars blocking access to their homes.

In an attempt to alleviate the problem, Town officials erected metal pole "No Parking" signs from the Yacht Club to Harbor Master Cove hoping it would control the excess traffic and allow enough space for emergency vehicles to pass should the need arise. However, that idea proved untenable by property owners who were left with no place to park for family, friends and landscapers, etc.

After a recent meeting at City Hall with property owners, the Town and the PPOA Board, a tentative agreement was devised on the plan you see detailed in the photo above.

The plan as proposed does allow parking on a portion of the land bridge on the M-dock side of the street beyond the emergency vehicle no-parking zone. With that said, overnight parking will be prohibited. Overnight M-dock owners can park to unload, but must then relocate their vehicles to the SHPYC parking lot.

We hope to hear feedback from Peninsula residents about this revised plan for a two weeks period (until September 23rd). The Town will make and announce a final decision then.
