



Tuesday, January 30th, 6:00pm
at The Peninsula Club Ballroom
about the increasing presence of
Lyngbya cyanobacteria algae in Lake Norman.



These photos illustrate the spread of the algae growth in coves near the Peninsula community. It has also been spotted in many nearby lake areas.



The meeting will include current information on Lyngbya in Lake Norman, Lyngbya in other NC lakes, and treatment options.

Local, state, and federal government officials as well as important stakeholder representatives (i.e., Charlotte Water and Duke Energy) have been invited.

Initiatives will be introduced to secure funding to treat Lyngbya beginning in April 2024 as a bulwark against further spread. A robust treatment plan with the goal of eradicating Lyngbya from Lake Norman will also be discussed.

All concerned residents are encouraged to attend.
