## **Tree Pruning**

From the Peninsula Property Association Landscape Committee:

As many of you are aware, the holly trees in our community have gotten very tall. Too tall. Over the past several days, our tree care contractor has been pruning the holly trees down to under sixteen feet (16").






This is a big job as our Peninsula Property Owners Association (PPOA) is responsible for maintaining the more than 400 holly trees in our community as well as magnolias, various hardwoods, and of course, pine trees. If the heavy equipment (bucket truck) is near your home, please be careful and steer clear of the work. Our goal is to bring all the holly trees to a height where they can be maintained as part of our routine landscape maintenance.

In addition to the holly trees, another tree care contractor will begin work next week

removing dead, dying, and/or dangerously leaning trees throughout the community. As you may have noticed, there is a pile of pine sections along Jetton Road. The large pine fell due to ground saturation blocking three of four lanes on Jetton Road. This was one of the trees scheduled for removal next week. The remaining sections will be removed as part of the upcoming work.
