Cornelius Police report a number of car break-ins recently. None have been reported in The Peninsula-- but several have happened in nearby businesses, including four last week in <u>The Shops At The Fresh Market</u> parking lot on Torrence Chapel Road.

Please lock your cars and there is <u>no overnight parking</u> on the street in The Peninsula.

IMPORTANT REMINDER

The Lake Norman Marine Commission in partnership with the North Carolina State University | Aquatic Plant Management Program are scheduled to begin surveying Lake Norman for Lyngbya cyanobacteria (blue-green algae) the week of March 25th.

It is important for homeowners to report the presence of Lyngbya in waters adjacent to their property so those locations may be added to or confirmed in the survey results necessary to an effective treatment plan.

Reporting is easy. click the button below, or, use this QR code to report suspicious plant growth along your shoreline:



Homeowners are our community's "Eyes on Lake Norman". Even if Lyngbya has not yet appeared this year, report where it appeared last year. We don't want to miss any locations requiring treatment and <u>reporting now is critical to success</u>!

Treatments are scheduled to begin in mid-April. If you see a "fan boat" along your shoreline, it will likely be applying treatment to eradicate the Lyngbya.


