ALICE REPRESENTS THE GROWING NUMBER OF HOUSEHOLDS IN OUR COMMUNITIES THAT EARN ENOUGH TO BE CONSIDERED ABOVE THE FEDERAL POVERTY LEVEL (FPL), BUT DO NOT EARN ENOUGH TO AFFORD BASIC NECESSITIES.

ALICE MAY BE YOUR RELATIVE, FRIEND, COLLEAGUE, OR NEIGHBOR, OR MAY ALSO BE YOUR HEALTH CARE PROVIDER, TEACHER, RETAIL CLERK, SANITATION WORKER, AND OTHERS.



ALICE HOUSEHOLDS:

- REPRESENT A DIVERSE CROSS-SECTION OF OUR COMMUNITIES, SPANNING ALL RACES, AGES, ETHNICITIES, AND ABILITIES, WITH HOUSEHOLDS OF COLOR DISPROPORTIONATELY AFFECTED
- INCLUDE INDIVIDUALS WORKING HARD IN JOBS WHERE WAGES HAVEN'T KEPT PACE WITH THE RISING COST OF LIVING
- OFTEN CONSIST OF PEOPLE JUGGLING MULTIPLE JOBS AND STILL STRUGGLING TO COVER BASIC EXPENSES
- FREQUENTLY INVOLVE CAREGIVERS SUPPORTING FAMILY MEMBERS, LIMITING THEIR ABILITY TO ACCESS STABLE, FULL-TIME EMPLOYMENT
- LIVE PAYCHECK TO PAYCHECK, MAKING DIFFICULT TRADE-OFFS EVERY DAY, LIKE CHOOSING BETWEEN RENT AND GROCERIES, HEALTHCARE AND CHILDCARE, OR UTILITIES AND TRANSPORTATION

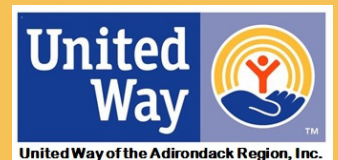
