FOR REALTORS® ~Steps toward homeownership program to help Realtors assist first time homeowners. This is virtual offered every quarter - go to CAR.org

Homeownership assistance programs ~ section 8 vouchers to rent and purchase a home. Ex. Hello Housing non profit in Bay Area ~ AC Boost program (funded by a bond measure) ~ layering down payment programs

Developing and sponsoring homeownership programs Special Purpose Credit Programs - allow credits - originate a loan for certain demographics like CAR's closing credit program

Working to expand homeownership and supply ADUs to reduce homeownership costs and build wealth Non profits are available to bridge the gaps for people of color to add an ADU to their property

Advocacy for home repairs or supporting funding for preventing foreclosure education To maintain black homeownership

Heirs Property Act - Uniform Law to allow homeowners that could lose their homes to be less vulnerable - creating wills or trusts.
