# **Housing**

- 1. Expand capacity of individuals to age in place (e.g., PACE, CAPABLE, assisted living)
- 2. Recruit existing residences to accommodate older adults
- 3. ADUs
- 4. Use Medicaid as a platform to cover housing costs

#### Health & Well Being

- 1. Strengthen direct care workforce
- 2. Increase support for in-home services and community housing options that enable aging in place
- 3. Advocate for or enact policy that supports provision of medical care in the home
- 4. Increase case management services to navigate healthcare system

### **Transportation**

- 1. Ensure transportation options to senior centers and age-related activities
- 2. Complete streets takes measures to provide alternatives to excessive driving and make streets more pedestrian-friendly
- 3. Encourage mixed-use development that prioritizes walkable access; retrofit existing development (office parks, shopping malls) to fulfill these conditions

#### **Socialization**

- 1. Integrate long-term care facilities into communities
- 2. Make socialization efforts available to older adults with different capabilities
- 3. Improve (para)transit options for older adults for socialization, civic engagement, and employment

### **Communications & Outreach**

- 1. Ensure that all services and supports are accessible, in multiple languages, and available in person, online, by mail and by phone; ensure use of ASL interpreters, closed captioning, large fonts and simple language
- 2. Increase awareness of Area Agencies on Aging
- 3. Expand digital access initiatives to older adults, including broadband coverage and cellular service

#### Common to all groups:

- Digital access, increase funding for PACE and JACC, sharing of services, access to home- and community-based services.
- Many services are the responsibility of local municipalities and/or county
