#### A WORD FROM OUR PASTOR



"Come to me, all you that are weary and are carrying heavy burdens, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you, and learn from me; for I am gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. For my yoke is easy, and my burden is light." – Matthew 11:28-30

Dear Friends,

I get it. I really do. You're tired. You're tired of worrying. You're tired of being careful. You're tired of being restricted. You're tired of life <u>not</u> being normal. So am I.

You may have been excited when you learned we planned to return to the sanctuary on July 5<sup>th</sup>. You may have thought to yourself, "It's about time!" Or, you may have thought to yourself, "I'm not ready." You may have then read that we were requiring masks for worship and felt your enthusiasm shrink. You're tired of wearing a mask. I get it.

But, we have an older congregation. The CDC still lists people above 65 as being in the "at risk" category of contracting COVID-19.

That means around nearly two thirds of our congregation is "at risk." The leadership of PCW, including myself, believe the responsible thing to do, to protect all of our worshippers, is to have everyone gathering to worship wear a mask when entering, when worshipping, and when leaving. Their health is more important than my comfort.

But, you're tired. We all are tired. How could we not be?

So, here we sit, everyone feeling tired. And, worship in the sanctuary resuming on July 5<sup>th</sup> felt like a glimmer of hope that some aspect of life was tracking toward normal. The last thing we want to hear is that inperson worship services are being postponed...again.

But, here we go again. And, I hope it's the last postponement and I wish I could promise that this is the last letter of this kind that I write. But I can't make that promise. I hope you all understand, but we have had to make the unfortunate decision to postpone in person worship for another two weeks. So, July 5<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> will still be considered "PCW@HOme" only.

The new target date to return to the sanctuary will be July 19<sup>th</sup>. I feel more confident we can make this work than previous target dates. The same restrictions of masks, social distancing, etc will still be in place.

So, now everyone probably feels even more tired. And, for that, I apologize and thank you for your continued patience. However, there is good news concerning our tiredness. The scripture passage at the beginning of this letter are words of Christ that I quote for most communion services. And, I believe they can be greatly comforting words at this time. We ARE tired. We ARE weary. We DO feel burdened.

The Good News is that Christ invites the tired, the weary, the burdened to come near to him and find REST. Christ is our sanctuary. He is our Sanctuary with a capital "S" even when we can't enter our church's sanctuary. Many of us feel rested and relieved when we gather to worship. And, I know many of you are chomping at the bit to feel that again.

But, Christ as our Sanctuary and Rest can be found anywhere! We can approach Christ sitting at home in front of the computer or TV. We can approach him in our cars, on walks, at work, at play. Rest is available at any time and in any place.

So, if you feel tired. And, I imagine most of you do. Find rest in Christ. Take time to worship, pray, meditate, slow down, contemplate, be quiet, etc.

Christ is gentle and humble in heart. May we feel likewise.
