Dear Friends,

The above verse is written into the very cornerstone of our church building. While it may sound initially harsh, there is eternal truth in the 29<sup>th</sup> Proverb: Where there is no vision, the people perish. Without a vision for the future, the church withers. Without a common goal to pursue, people lose enthusiasm. Without mission, the church loses its purpose.

I am very proud of our Presbytery for adopting a shared vision for 2019: "Uprooting Hunger." In the year of 2019, the year that I serve as Presbytery Moderator, the congregations of the Presbytery of Giddings-Lovejoy will work together to create a massive effort to combat hunger and foster greater food justice, both in our region and around the world. At our December meeting, your Session voted to join the Presbytery's vision by becoming a Hunger Action Congregation! As such, "Uprooting Hunger" will also be PCW's vision for 2019 as well.

So, what is a Hunger Action Congregation (HAC)? These congregations have achieved official certification by participating in six categories of Hunger Action: 1. Hunger Alleviation, 2. Development Assistance, 3. Hunger Education, 4. Lifestyle Integrity, 5. Corporate and Public Policy Witness, and 6. Worship.

The first step toward becoming a HAC has already happened! Through our Weekend Meals on Wheels Program, Mission Garden and other ministries, we already do work in one of those six categories: Hunger Alleviation. That means we have achieved the status of "Covenanting" Hunger Action Congregation. And, for our existing efforts, we will receive a \$100 grant for our Weekend Meals on Wheels ministry.

To become a "Certified" Hunger Action Congregation, the Mission/Outreach Committee and I will ensure that PCW participates somehow in all six categories during 2019. When we reach that status, the Presbytery will award us with another grant in the amount of \$250 for the Weekend Meals on Wheels ministry.

According to the Presbyterian Hunger Program of our General Assembly, one in every seven people in Missouri are facing some sort of hunger crisis. The national average is one out of eight. In Missouri, one out of every six children struggles with hunger. And, we believe that God calls the church of Jesus Christ to some sort of action.

We may not be able to feed everyone, we may not be able to

solve the hunger problem. But, PCW *can* make a difference. And, as we partner with the other congregations of this Presbytery, we can make a significant difference in 2019.


### Harvest Table



Did you make New Year's Resolutions for 2019? If you did so, are you still holding to them? I made some resolutions that I make every year and never really accomplish. I have a new plan for this year to achieve success. I'll have to wait and see if my new plan works.

I did make one brand new resolution I never made before: to read one Psalm or one Proverb each day. There are 150 Psalms, so I'll read through the Book of Psalms twice (that's 300 days) and then once through the Book of (31) Proverbs, which equals 331 days. That leaves 34 days, which will get me to next year's Advent when I shall do something else.

David did not compose all the psalms. David's psalms are Book I of the Psalms (the first 41), and more of David's psalms are sprinkled throughout the rest. There are numerous authors, some of whom are named. There are five Book

divisions, to correspond to the first five books of the Bible, the Torah. Book II is a hodge podge. Psalms of Asaph are in Book III. Book IV begins with Psalm 90, a psalm of Moses, and ends with Psalm 106. Book V begins at 107.

There are different kinds of psalms/hymns/songs that speak to different circumstances, feelings, events, and liturgical acts in worship. Enthronement psalms celebrated the Lord's kingship and Songs of Zion celebrated the Holy City. Lament psalms were an individual's asking relief from illness, false accusation, persecution or the whole nation seeking help in times of distress. Songs of Trust were an individual's or nation's expression of confidence in God to help, while Thanksgiving psalms expressed gratutide after the fact for God's help at time of dis-Wisdom psalms were tress. meditations on life and the ways of God.
