"Advent" means "coming" or "arrival." During the season of Advent, we cele-

> brate Christ's coming into the world and watch with expectant hope for his coming again. In its historical origins, the season of Advent was patterned after the season of Lent, a six-week period of penitence and preparation for Easter. Similarly, the four weeks of Advent present an opportunity for communal discernment and personal examination, as the church prepares to celebrate the Nativity of the Lord and looks with hope for Christ's return. (PCUSA Mission Agency)

PCW CONNECT Penitence and preparation, communal discernment and personal examination. Who does that as they prepare for Christmas and Jesus' second coming? Who does that during the four weeks of Advent? There's no time for that, right???

We prepare for sure. We decorate our homes inside and out. We make cookies and other homemade goodies. We go to parties and gatherings, plays and pageants. We watch our favorite Christmas movies which rarely have anything to do with celebrating the birth of the Christ child. We shop 'til we drop hoping to find the perfect gift for each person on our list.

Is Jesus on your shopping list? Have you discerned what to give him? Have you engaged in personal examination? This Advent time of preparation is really personal. It's not about all the activities we think of as we prepare for Christmas. It's about how to welcome Jesus once again, preparing our hearts as our gift for Jesus. it's about thanksgiving and praise for what God has done for us.

To help us prepare, the hymn "O Lord, How Shall I Meet You" (Number 11 in the Presbyterian Hymnal) can be used as a daily prayer. It can help us refocus on the season of Advent rather than jumping right into Christmas. On the next page are the lyrics of the hymn.


