

Masks

Whenever I leave my house I now practice social distancing and wear a mask. I do so for several reasons.

- 1. Because I believe what is being said in the media.
- 2. That Heather and I, both have chronic physical issues that make us susceptible to potentially deadly results of contracting the virus, neither of us want to bring it home.
- 3. Most importantly perhaps of all, I wear a mask because I believe that doing so is a visible symbol of our Christian mission to provide for the safety and wellbeing of everyone – our family, friends, neighbors and all around us. But wearing a mask has contradictory outcomes. While we want to be more united to one another we find that by wearing masks we necessarily distance ourselves from one another.

I have been perusing an art book, 1000 Faces of God by Rebecca Hind (Barnes & Noble, New York, 2004) that has pictures of how visual artists of faith throughout history have pictured their God(s) through paintings, drawings, plaques, sculpture, and architecture. None of them claimed that facial features were actual "photos" of their pagan-Greek-Roman-Judeo-Christian-Muslim-Hindu-Buddhist-Sik-or Eastern Mystic God, but that the faces showed are the true, spiritual attributes of their godhead. Sections of the book that deal with Jesus as the Son of God point out that it is not necessary to know that Jesus might have had a crooked nose, or maybe a mole on his cheek, or how full a beard he might have had. It is important to know how and what Jesus was feeling when he paid attention to children as other adults ignored them in public, when he healed the sick and dying, when he preached and taught multitudes in public or spoke with disciples privately.

We all wear masks when we go in public. If not a physical, visible mask, we each have a public persona we choose to show to the world of how we want to be perceived and known. (And yes, I know that sometimes our chosen masks slip!) But I suspect that Jesus, the Son of God, Our Savior, never wore a mask. He was always himself, the world made of flesh. Otherwise there would have been no point in the incarnation; we can only understand God by knowing the Son as himself fully engaged with humanity, as unmasked God. –Jocelyn VanBuskirk

Pecan Mini Muffin Recipe

Pecan Mini Muffins

½ c. butter
2 eggs
1 c. dark brown sugar
½ c. flour
1 tsp. vanilla
1 ½ c. chopped pecans
nonstick cooking spray



Melt butter, then cool. Add eggs and brown sugar to butter and mix by hand. Add flour, vanilla and nuts and mix by hand again. Spray small tins with nonstick cooking spray and fill to top. Bake 20 minutes at 350 degrees. Enjoy!!!




