Dear Friends,

Education often gets overlooked in church life. We often feel that once we grow up, we pretty much know everything we need to know about faith matters. But, there is always more to learn. And, participating in a book study and/or an adult class can really help open our eyes and hearts to the spiritual growth available to us in furthering our Christian education. And, one of the best ways to learn is actually to teach!

The above quote from Proverbs speaks to the importance of education for children. Teach them how to live when they are young, and they will live that out when they group up. This is generally very true. However, I have heard countless times over my years from new Sunday School or VBS teachers a similar refrain: "I think I learned just as much as the kiddos did!"

Teaching takes many forms. Obviously, we need and value teachers in our Sunday school classroom. But, we teach kids so often in how we choose to <u>live</u>. Kids watch adults to pattern their own behavior. If they see us live out the Gospel in service, compassion, kindness and gentleness, they learn what God expects from them. By living right, we train children to live right themselves.

And don't forget, we never really "graduate" from Christian Education. There is always more to learn, understand and experience when it comes to spiritual matters. We'll never be perfect in our understanding, but God still expects us to make progress and grow in our faith. The closest thing we may experience to "graduation" from our Christian Education is...well, at the risk of sounding grim...death.

Don't be afraid to attend a class or study. So many people are afraid that they'll look stupid or embarrassed that they don't know more than people may expect them to know. You'll likely be surprised that many people are experiencing the same fear in our classrooms.

And don't forget how much we can learn when we teach. Live your life as an example, sub in a Sunday School classroom, help out in the nursery, dip your toe into the book club. The benefits far outweigh the risk.



- sausage and sauerkraut
- bread pudding

Washington Churches and Loving Hearts Donate New School Supplies for Children in Need.

Almost 200 children who attend Washington Public Schools in grades K-6 received a free backpack filled with new student supplies suitable for their grade level. Members of First Washington United Methodist Church, Presbyterian Church of Washington, Jubilee Church, and friends of Loving Hearts Outreach donated school supplies that were given to children whose families would have a financial hardship paying for the materials. "Any child who needed school supplies was welcome to get a backpack," said Rev. Troy Merseal, pastor at First Washington United Methodist Church. "The school district notified the students, and we provided the supplies. This project took months of planning, with Margilee Laborde in our congregation serving as chairman."



Each donating organization collected specific items. One group, for example, asked its members for 95 rolls of paper towels, 125 boxes of Kleenex tissues, 91 disinfectant wipes, and 91 bottles of hand sanitizers. Another group collected 215 boxes of 24-count crayons, 232 boxes of #2 pencils, and large quantities of 13 other supplies. The total value of supplies donated is estimated to be at least \$4,000.

The donated supplies were all assembled and packed at First Washington United Methodist Church and distributed at South Point Elementary School on Saturday, August 13 from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. on a first-come first-served basis. Since each school mandates its own supply list for each class,

every backpack was labeled for a specific class and school. A few backpacks were donated to Washington Early Learning Center and Washington Middle School.

"If you haven't looked at a school supply list for about 20 years," noted Jolene Patterson, Mission Committee chairman at



the Presbyterian Church of Washington, "you would be

shocked at the number of items required, and the cost of them. Those of us who worked on this project were also shocked at the generosity of people who donated supplies to us. This was a wonderful project, and the whole community benefits when children have basic supplies to begin a new school year."


