Thank you for your patience as we move ahead with our parish office relocation to the Chancery Office (168 Hawthorne Street) and as we prepare for restoration to begin at St. Ninian Place.

We know that within challenges lies opportunities. One challenge with fixing the damage to St. Ninian Place is the issue of cost balanced against the insurance payout. There are parishioners who suggest repairing what has been damaged, "like for like", is the only solution. There are other parishioners who wish for improvements to the space such as installing air conditioning and improving the kitchen design at St. Ninian Place. Then there are others who see the space as a revenue source; but only if it can be upgraded to market value including amenities people wish to have if they rent the space.

Many of you face these issues in your own homes. Do you renovate to keep the market value of your home or do you make do with what you have. These are the questions that are being discussed regarding the repairs.
