A message from Father Danny...

It is good to be back with you after some time away visiting family and friends. Seeing you at last weekend's Masses and hearing your messages of warm welcome is always wonderful and I am most grateful!

As you may already know, last Sunday around 8:30pm a pipe burst in St. Ninian's Place. I had just left the office around 8pm and arrived home when I was called back due to the alarm.

What a surprise greeted me! The water was falling like rain and, within minutes, I was standing in inches of water. Parish staff and parishioners were called and came to help retrieve precious materials, but the damage to the facility was extensive. The parish's offices, the link, the kitchen in St. Ninian Place, floors, walls, ceilings, computers, were all damaged.

We are grateful there was no damage to the church, vestry, and sacristy.

For the next few months, St. Ninian Place will be under construction. Please do not use the doors to the link; and do not enter St. Ninian Place or the parish offices. The building is closed except for authorized personnel.

Parish Staff are moved to the Chancery Office at 168 Hawthorne Street. We are grateful to our Bishop for his generosity in accommodating us at the Chancery. Our phone number remains the same and shortly our email systems will be working. 2022 Tax receipts can be picked up at the Chancery.

A subcommittee of the Building and Grounds Committee has been asked to define the scope of repair work. This is the next task and perhaps the next opportunity. Is it an opportunity to rethink and perhaps refresh our space. For example, could the kitchen in St. Ninian Place be redesigned? While the general contractor is on site, it might be cost effective to do some things now rather than wait until another day. You might have some ideas or thoughts on what can be done and I am happy to hear from you.
