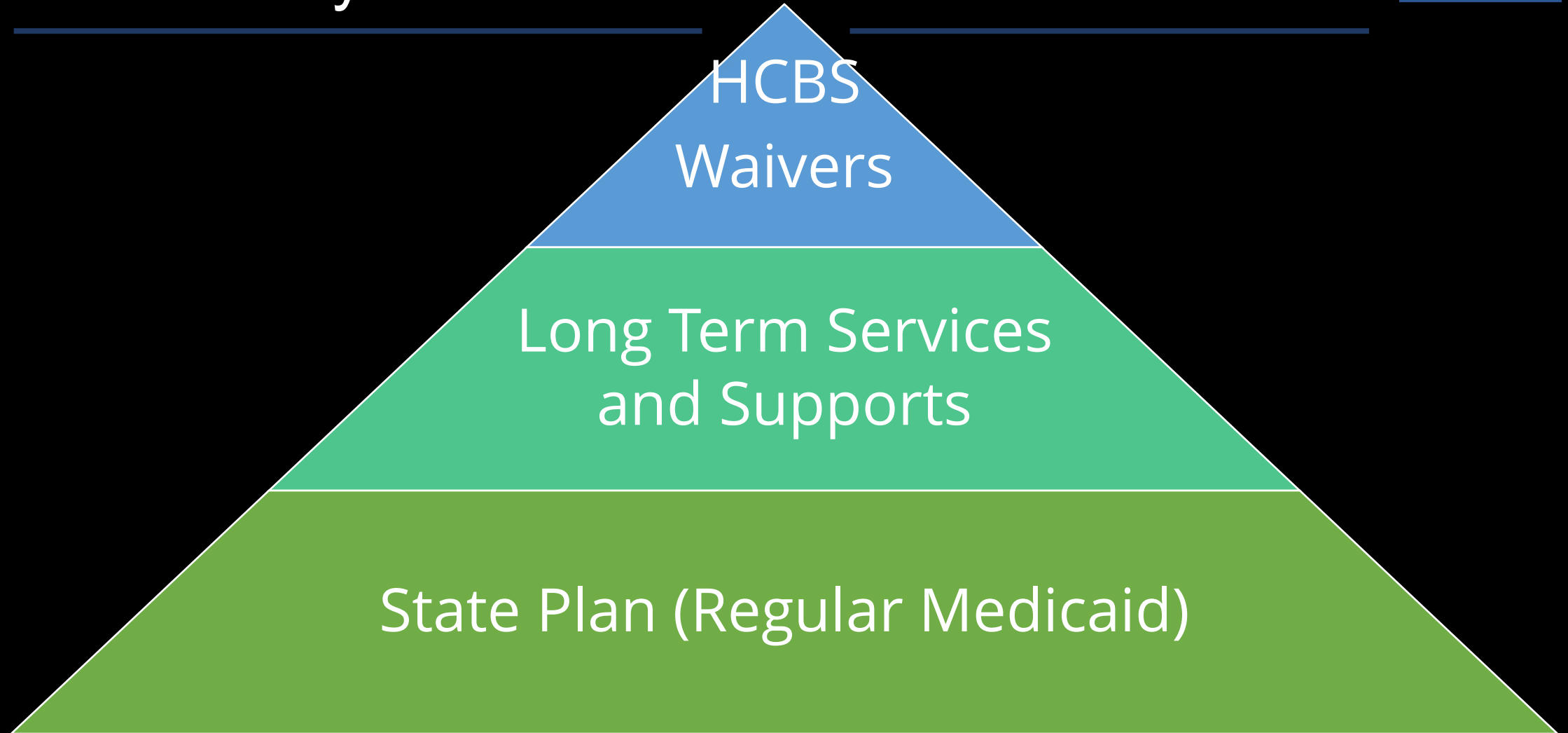

Waiver Eligibility



There are 3 primary eligibility factors for all HCBS waivers

Financial

- Determined by County Human Services Office

Level of Care

- Determined by Case Management Agency

Targeting Criteria

- Determined by Case Management Agency

Waitlist/Transitioning from Child to Adult Services


14 – Waitlist eligible

17 years old – Learn about adult waivers

17 ½ years old – Contact your case manager/coordinator

18 years old – Apply for Adult SSI and explore guardianship

21 years old – School and Pediatric Medicaid end

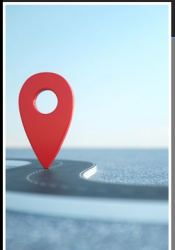

- Individuals living with their parents can access DD waiver supports under Family Caregiver Act
