COVID SAFETY

All our classes will be conducted in line with government guidelines to ensure the safety of every student, parent and teacher. NEW CLASSES

We have introduced a new Beginner's Tap Class on Thursdays from 6.15 - 7.00pm in Byfleet. This class is for all those 'late starters' and will allow students to learn the basics and gain a general knowledge of the tap style with the aim of the student eventually being able to join a tap grade suitable for their age group.

There is now an additional Grade 5 ballet class on Mondays from 7.25 - 8.25pm. Grade 5 is one of the more challenging grades and it is really beneficial for the students to take two classes per week in this grade to help them become familiar with the syllabus more quickly. The RAD guided learning hours for this grade is a total of 75 hours with an additional 20 hours of tuition before taking the exam! We highly recommend taking two classes per week if possible.
