- Conducts conversations with visitors of all ages, interests, abilities, and backgrounds to bring about new understandings of history
- Provides approved interpretation of an assigned historic structure
- Provides either first person or third person narrative, as assigned
- Directs visitors to other parts of the site
- Participate in annual and ongoing training to build professional knowledge in historical content, interpretive techniques, and educational theory
- Reports any maintenance issues to the Maintenance Technician or any curatorial issues to the Curator

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, AND ABILITIES:

- Skilled at verbal communications with visitors, staff, volunteers, and community
- Ability to interpret historical collections and communicate knowledge relevant to the collections in a manner that is understandable to the general public
