

The Role of a Contemplative Outreach Chapter Coordinator/Coordinating Team

A coordinator generally serves in a volunteer capacity and in accordance with the <u>Contemplative Outreach (CO) Vision</u>, <u>Theological Principles and Commentaries</u>, and the <u>Guidelines for Contemplative Service and Commentaries</u>. Coordinators are chosen through a prayerful discernment process to serve for a three-year term which is renewable as determined by the chapter. Preparation for CO servant leaders is detailed in the <u>Coordinator Appointment Guidelines</u>.

It is recommended that the coordinator serve the chapter along with a coordinating team. This team approach serves to lessen the administration for the role of coordinator and provides opportunities for sharing responsibilities for the chapter programs and services.

A coordinator:

- allows his/her name and contact information to be listed on the CO website, in CO publications and local chapter publications.
- serves with the coordinating team to provide chapter programs: the Centering Prayer Introductory Program; ongoing Centering Prayer group facilitator support and enrichment; silent days of prayer; other enrichment programs and retreats. Additional team members may be needed for finances and book/resource orders, maintaining the chapter website and data base, as well publicizing events.
- schedules, plans agenda and facilitates coordinating team meetings.
- provides information, such as the yearly financial report and chapter census, as requested.
- networks with the CO Chapter Support Service Team and with other coordinators in their respective geographical areas when planning special programs or events, speakers, and intensive retreats.
- recommends and provides formation using the newly-developed presenter formation resources for qualified persons to become commissioned presenters for offering the Centering Prayer Introductory Program.
- may request financial assistance for the chapter from CO via Marie Howard, Coordinator of Volunteers.
