Additionally, she teaches bridge at Madison College and MSCR. She wrote a bridge column for the Wisconsin State Journal for over a year and also wrote a book on bridge that sold out.

A player needs 500 points to become a master bridge player which Glenna says usually takes 3-10 years to achieve. She has a whopping 7,000 points and is the only master teacher in Wisconsin and one of just three in the Midwest!
