2023 Fitchburg Tax Info — AARP

This year, returns will be prepared with two short appointments on the same day: 1) Brief interview, and leave your documents with the tax preparers after you (and spouse) sign consent form; 2) Pick up your documents and sign for your completed tax return two to four hours later.

Come prepared

Intake forms and instructions must be picked up at the Fitchburg Senior Center and filled out completely BEFORE your appointment. Bring the following to your appointment: signed and completed intake forms; photo ID for taxpayer(s); Social Security card or Social Security statement with social security number on it for everyone listed on your return; 2021 federal and state tax returns; verification of income including, but not limited to, SA-1099, 1099-R, 1099-INT, 1099-DIV, 1099-B, W-2; blank check if you want direct deposit. If filing for Homestead, you must bring 2022 original rent certificate without any mistakes, and/or 2022 property tax bill.

Tax Aide volunteers are only permitted to help with simple tax returns. Examples of returns that they CANNOT prepare: Divorce finalized in 2022; married filing separately; hobby income; most selfemployment income; farm income; rental income; and other less common situations.

ALL appointments are on Fridays, February 10 through April 7. Call 608-270-4290 to request a timeslot.



Case Manager Corner W/ Amy

Over the next few months, we will be exploring four future trends for Senior Care. This month's trend is Telehealth. Telehealth gained traction during the pandemic and is here to stay. UW Health, Group Health Cooperative and SSM Health all offer Telehealth. Telehealth can be used for urgent and non-urgent conditions. The most frequently seen are pink eye, bladder infections, colds, and flu. What can you expect from the visit? You will be able to speak to a licensed medical professional; however, it may not be your primary care provider as not all PCPs participate in telehealth. You can use your phone, iPad or computer. They can and do prescribe medications when needed. You will need an account (such as My Chart) at your current clinic to access this service. This service is good for people with mobility and transportation issues, as well as not having to travel to a clinic when you are feeling poorly due to a common ailment. If you need assistance with setting up your phone or computer with an account, contact the Fitchburg Senior Center Social Work department; we can help with account setup, reviewing technology basics and providing assistance to ensure a smooth first telehealth visit.




