Our Guide to Re-Opening safely Emergency Order #15

To sum it up, nothing has really changed. This order went into effect on April 7. While it has loosened some restrictions for outdoor activities (no masks necessary if maintain six—foot distancing), indoor regulations remain the same. You must wear a mask and maintain six—foot distancing. Our staff are not allowed to ask for proof of vaccination. This is a personal choice and cannot be a requirement to participate in Senior Center activities. Therefore, we CANNOT guarantee that all who come to the Center will be vaccinated. It will also be a personal choice of when you feel comfortable returning to the Senior Center.

Here are steps we are taking to safely ease back into our opening in May:

- ♦ Doors will be open from 8:00 a.m.—4:00 p.m. If you need to meet with staff, appointments are strongly encouraged.
- For programs offered during the month of May, advanced registration will be required.
- ♦ Rooms will be pre—arranged to allow for six—foot distancing. Chairs/tables should not be moved.
- ◆ A select number of programs will be offered in—person and on Zoom. Check our website www.fscprograms.com or give us a call 270–4290 for the latest updates.
- Building will be sanitized each morning and surfaces will be re—sanitized throughout the day.


Caregiver Support In-Person

2021 Senior Farmers' Market Vouchers

The Area Agency on Aging (AAA) of Dane County offers vouchers to seniors for use in purchasing \$25 worth of fruits, vegetables or herbs at farmers' markets and roadside farm stands in Wisconsin during the 2021 season (June through October). Vouchers will be distributed on a first come/first serve basis to Dane County residents age 60 or older who have gross incomes under \$23,828 per year (\$1,986/month) for a one-person household, or \$32,227 (\$2,686/month) for a two-person household. Only one set of vouchers will be distributed per household.

Past participants will receive an application in the mail along with instructions for this year's program. For those who have never participated in the program and wish to apply, contact AAA Dietitian Shannon Gabriel at 261-5678. Vouchers will be distributed to approved applicants via USPS starting June 1. If you have questions, you can also call the Fitchburg Senior Center at 270-4290 and ask to speak with a Social Worker.

Transportation Options for Now...

Transit Solutions is committed to making sure older adults have what they need during this challenging time. Below are services that the Senior Center and Transit Solutions are collaborating to provide:

<u>Shopping/Errands</u> - The bus can take you for groceries or to general shopping locations. Rides are limited to two passengers at a time. You may also schedule a ride to the bank or pharmacy.

<u>Grocery Delivery</u> - If you are able to order your groceries online, Transit will pick up your order and deliver to your home.

<u>Medical Appointments</u> – During the shut-down, you still have transportation options for medical appointments. If you need a ride, call the Dane County Transportation Call Center at 242-6489.

The Social Work Picture

If you are having difficulty with essential daily activities, call the Fitchburg Senior Center and ask to speak with a Social Worker. They are happy to talk through your concerns over the phone, and if necessary and circumstances permit, can arrange a home visit. In-person appointments at the Fitchburg Senior Center are also available. You must call either Amy Jordan (270-4295) or Sarah Folkers (270-4294) to schedule an appointment. Walk-in appointments are not available at this time.

Home Delivered Meals & Little Johns!

Starting in May, we will be delivering to MOST of our home delivered meal routes on Wednesdays. We hope to be delivering to everyone on Wednesdays by June. Please sit tight if you are not delivered a meal on Wednesday, we're working on it! In the meantime, our Social Workers will be completing home delivered meal reassessments. These assessments are done annually to make sure that everyone who is getting meals delivered still qualifies for the program.

We are happy to announce our new partnership with Little Johns! Home delivered meal clients are now receiving extra meals on Tuesdays and Fridays thanks to this unbelievably generous organization. If you haven't heard of this nonprofit group, a short synopsis is this: Little Johns is proudly serving as the community's home for healthy, chef-quality, and affordable meals created while decreasing local food excess.




