

RE STAGINE BOULDER HIGHWAY

PEDESTRIAN & BICYCLIST IMPROVEMENTS

The Reimagine Boulder Highway project has incorporated a variety of elements designed to enhance safety in the corridor for all users:

- Sight-distance improvements for motorists
- Pedestrian refuge islands, widened crosswalks, and shorter crossing distances
- Improved benches, seating and shelters
- Continuous pedestrian access along the corridor
- Adjacent bicycle tracks

SIGHT-DISTANCE IMPROVEMENTS

Treatments to improve motorists' line of sight while driving include a combination of crosswalk enhancements, lighting improvements, and other modifications to slow turning speeds at intersections.

TRANSIT STATIONS

Improved benches, seating and shelters at transit stations provide design and comfort amenities to increase physical separation from vehicular traffic and provide features for relief from traffic stress and other environmental factors.

CONTINUOUS PEDESTRIAN ACCESS

The project includes plans for continuous access for pedestrians with frequent driveway cuts on both sides of the street, pedestrian crossings, and adjacent bicycle lanes.
