All fabric will be 20% off regular price; 20% off all precuts, fat quarters and fat quarter bundles, notions, rulers, kits, and patterns. Illusions – A block of the month by Scott Flanagan featuring Northcott Banyan Batiks. Cindy Shock will be leading you through this wonderful sampler and teaching new techniques each month – ranging from straight piecing, flying geese, applique, paper piecing and curved piecing. Confident Beginner. Classes will be on Saturdays from 10:00-2:00pm on the following days March 26, April 23, May 21, June 25, July 23, August 27, Sept 24, October 22, November 19, December 17, Jan 21, 2023 and February 24, 2023. Kits are required for this class – regular price is \$325.00 per kit – Class sale price is \$260.00. Instructor fee is \$15.00 per day – payable in trimesters of \$60.00 upon signup - \$60.00 in June and \$60.00 in October.

Storm at Sea – A technique class featuring the Creative Grids Square on Square Trim Tool and the 2 peaks in 1 rulers. Amy Golden will be teaching these must have rulers – showing you numerous ways to use them and inspiring you to use your creativity as well.

Amy will be offering this class twice – the first date will be Wednesday, March 23rd or on Wednesday, April 13th from 10:00 – 3:00pm – cost \$20.00 per day.

Underground Railroad Sampler Class - \$150.00 for 15 – 2 1/2-hour classes. Linda Banker will be the instructor.

This is a great sampler class teaching different techniques to a confident beginner, or just as a great refresher class. The class sample is made from Sandy Gervais newest fabric collection *Adele in Spring* – however, Kansas Troubles is another great suggestion for this class.

You may choose either the 1:00-3:30pm class or the evening class of 5:30-8:00pm.

Dates: March 29: April 5, 12, 19: May 3, 10, 17, 24, 31: June 7, 14, 21 and July 12, 19, and 26.

Beginner Quilting: Are you new to Quilting?? Do you need to brush up on the basics?? This class came about to get it done right. When you complete the class, you will be confident to take other classes and tackle your favorite patterns. We will start with selecting fabric – right on through to putting the binding on – step by step. This is a five-week class and is available as a **Thursday day class from 1:00 – 3:30pm or Thursday evening class from 5:30pm – 8:00pm.** Class fee \$50.00

Dates: March 24, 31 and April 7, 14, 21.

Quilting #2 – let's take it a little further. Machine applique and some machine quilting techniques will be taught. This is a great class to follow up the Beginner Class. The Dresden Plate is an old-time favorite but a great teaching block. Linda Banker will be leading you on this 3-week course with both an afternoon and an evening class on May 5, 12 and 19th – 1:00 – 3:30pm or 5:30 – 8:00pm available. Instructor fee: \$30.00.

Wackeroo – Saturday, April 16th from 9:30am – 3:30pm – Instructor fee \$40.00 – Class led by Linda Banker – This is another great stack n whack quilt. Using a twisted setting really adds to the look of this quilt. Remember, when you are looking for your focus fabric – color is more important than design.

Fabric Wrapped Clothesline Bowl – These bowls are having a resurgence. The possibilities are endless. We will go over all different sizes and shapes and how to get them accomplished. Embellishments will also be taught in this Friday evening class – April 22nd from 5:30-8:00pm. Instructor Linda Banker – Fee \$20.00

Star quilt - such a sweet quilt. Using the cat's cradle ruler and a different setting your stars will look so much harder to make than they are. This fun block can be used in a table runner, or any size quilt you desire. This is a great technique class taught by Linda Banker – Saturday, July 9 – 9:30am – 3:30pm - \$40.00

One Block Wonder – the name says it all. One piece of fabric, one shape and a one-of-a-kind quilt. You will fall in love with this unusual method of designing and creating a quilt. Kaleidoscope blocks made and you begin to design your quilt. Linda Banker will be teaching this class on Friday, May 27 from 5:30pm – 8:00pm and finish on Saturday May 28 – 9:30am – 3:30pm. Instructor fee \$60.00

Almost Amish Cat's Cradle – one look at this quilt and everyone thinks – oh no – to many triangles. You will never cut out or sew a triangle in this project. Creative grid cat's cradle tool is awesome and you will even make 2 blocks at once using squares and rectangles. Linda Banker will be leading this class on Saturday, June 11th from 9:30am – 3:30pm – Cost \$40.00.

Table Topper of the Month – Riley Blake had a different designer each month to make a beautiful 36" x 36" seasonal project. Sign up and we will hold all the kits for you – or just choose which months you would like to get. The kits will be \$48.00 each month and includes all the fabrics except backing. This will also include a free sit n sew day on the **second Friday of each month** to come in and make your table toppers while enjoying time with your quilting friends. Starts on March 11 at 10:00am – 3:00pm.
