

The 2020 History Game

OFFICIAL RULES AND GUIDELINES:

Participate in the "History Game" and Learn a little about your country while enjoying a ride on your motorcycle. Many communities have markers along the highway which denote the site of a Heritage Registered property or a National Register site. These are the infamous "brown signs" along state highways. Take a photograph with the 2020 Touring Handbook Cover, and of your bike at one of these sites. Make your ride a learning experience, while you are there learn of the significance of that particular location via the heritage marker.

NOTE: Photos will NOT be returned.

PARTICIPATION

Any GNW Chapter member may enter.

Entries must be submitted individually. Multiple entries cannot be combined on one.

All photos submitted become the property of GNW Chapter. Photos, along with participant's name, may be used in publications, promotions, and other Chapter purposes. Submitted photos will not be returned.

Individuals participate at their own risk.

PHOTO ELEMENTS

- Your Harley-Davidson motorcycle or a rental (proof of rental required) must be in each photo.
- The cover of the 2020 H.O.G. 50 Rides must be clearly identifiable in each photo. Go to GNW-HOG.com to download a printable version of the 2020 50 Rides and start your adventure ASAP.
- You, the entrant, must be in at least five of the photos
- An "official marker or plaque" must be in each photo. (This may be excluded if unable to obtain)
- A description of the historical significance and the approximate location of the photo.

EARNING POINTS

Ride to a location with a Heritage marker and snap a picture within the guidelines above. Each marker has a 1 point value, the rider with the most points will obtain some great rides and good times, the possibility of good stories, and the bragging rights until the following season's winner is announced.

Photos will NOT be returned. All entries must be submitted no later than November 1, 2020 or the Chapter meeting in November 2020.

SUBMIT ENTRIES

Entry submissions are to be made at the end of the season Pot Luck in November. Submissions can also be made by creating a Microsoft Word document with the pictures and descriptions (in one document) and e-mailing it to webmaster@GNW-HOG.com.
