Day 1:

Today we shoot down I5 to one of the most beautiful roads you'll ever be on. The Historic Columbia River Highway has some beautiful scenery such as: Vista House, and many falls including Multnomah Falls. Just after getting on the historic highway we will have lunch at Sugarpine Drive-in. We will jump back onto the new Hwy 30 were we will see Vista House, Latourell Falls, Bridal Veil Falls, and Multnomah Falls on the way to the Bridge of the gods motel.

East on 188th St SW
Right onto 44th Ave W.
On ramp to I5 on the right



Exit 59: toward Vader Chevron at end of ramp (127 mi stop for fuel)

Exit: 7 to I205 South
Exit 22 to the Dalles onto Hwy 30/84
Exit 18 toward Lewis and Clark State
Park
Left onto Historic Columbia River
Highway 30



Sugarpine Driv-in

Take exit 18 from I-84 E/US-30 E Take first right into Troutdale the Sugarpine Drive-in is on the left just over bridge. Take a right out of Sugarpine Drive-in. Right back onto Historic Columbia Highway

Continue on Historic Columbia Highway toward Bridal Veil Falls

Continue on Historic Columbia Highway toward Multnomah Falls



Continue on Historic Columbia Highway toward Hood River. Merge onto Hwy 30/84 East


Exit 44 to Cascade locks

Today's Travel: Approximately 284 Miles, 6 Hours and 19 Minutes

Day 2:

Today we cross the Bridge of the God's (a 1.00\$ toll is required) and travel along the side of the Columbia River (on the Washington side) to our first destination in Zillah Washington. On the way we will stop for a break and gas In Goldendale In Zillah we will pick up a good photo opportunity with a stop at an iconic roadside attraction, the Teapot Dome gas station while this is a "gas station" it does not serve gas, so we will stop near by for gas in Zillah. We will then head to lunch at the famous Miner's Drive in restaurant in Yakima. After eating lunch we'll head home on 410 and make a brief fuel stop at Whistlin' Jack's then onward to Mount Rainier National Park. We'll go past Enumclaw and through Black Diamond.



Bridge of the Gods Motel

(Departure 8:30am w/ full tanks and bladders empty)



Bridgeside (across the street and just to the left) for breakfast but we may play it by ear. over bridge. ((Grate) (1.00\$ toll Required for 1 bike no passenger))

Right: onto Evergreen Hwy 14 Vere left toward Goldendale on to Hwy 97



Left: at Dingman Rd. to **Chevron** for a break and gas if needed (you should be able to make it to Zillah). Straight through Toppenish onto Hwy 22

East: I-82 to Zillah to **Exit 52** (Next exit)



Left: onto Meyers Rd turns into 1st St. to Teapot.



Right: onto 1st Ave. right again onto Vintage Valley Prkwy to Shell gas station.


I-82 West: on ramp to Yakima.

Exit 36: to Vally Mall Blvd. Take second exit form round about to Valley Mall Blvd. Take first round about exit to Rudkin on second round about.

Left: on Rainier Pl. to 18t St.

Right: on to S. 18th St. to Washington Ave.

Left: on Washington Ave. to light on 14th St.





Left: to Miners for lunch. Back the way we came to Hwy 97

Exit 31: West 12 to Naches White Pass.

Straight: onto Hwy 410 to Whistlin' Jack's.



Left: to Whistlin' Jack's, some may want to take the opportunity to fuel up.

Left: onto Hwy 410 Past the Palisades and **Rainier National Park** entrance is Lake Tipsoo (Mnt Baker National Forest on other side) Continue on Hwy 410 the first road in Enumclaw.



Through Light: At Griffit. To stop at the 76 station on right for fuel if needed and a break

Left: onto Griffin Ave to 169.

Right: onto Hwy 169 / Maple Valley Road.

Left: at light on 152nd Ave SE. to Starbucks on the left.



Left: to Starbucks.



My favorite thing between Yakima and Whislin Jack's is the man being chased up a tree. This is about 35 miles from Yakima on the left just before Whistlin Jack's.



The trip will end at the Starbucks. I hope you can join me on what has become my favorite ride since I have been riding street bikes.
