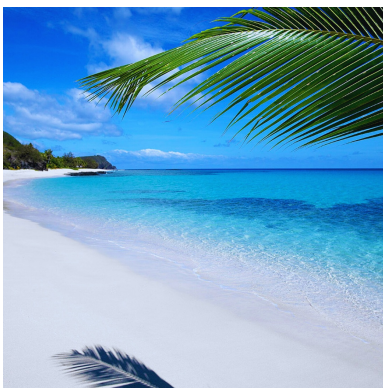
Once you have gathered your ideas, book an appointment with us. Our team will start working on your dream multi-gen holiday to suit the whole family.
