#### **Where to stay?**

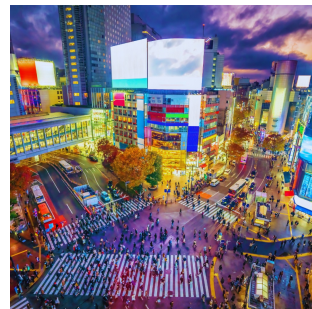
