What is Evaluation?

 Systematic and objective assessment of an ongoing or completed project or program.

Why is Evaluation important?

- Allows your program to align with participant needs.
- Informs stakeholders about your program.
- Provides data for program funding.




When should we implement evaluations?

Evaluation Approaches

Qualitative: Observations or information are expressed using categories rather than numerical terms.

Quantitative: Information that is collected is expressed in numerical terms.

Tools: Focus Groups, Openended questions on Questionnaires **Tools: Questionnaires**



What are we measuring?

Outputs

 The products, goods, or services which result from the project or program.

Number of people, number of meals passed out, etc.

Outcomes and Impact

 A result or effect caused by or attributed to the project or program.


Awareness, Knowledge, Behavior, Condition


What can we do with all of this evaluation data?
