Factors Driving Our Planning

- 1.** To always consider and provide what is best for students
- 2.** To maintain a safe physical environment
- 3.** To meet students' needs for predictability and continuity of learning
- 4.** To ensure an academic focus that is supported with social/emotional learning
- 5.** To maintain and build effective student-teacher relationships

General Safety Protocols

The safety protocols that are already in place and will be followed when we return to campus include:



Daily screening system (including iPass App system to be explained later)



Supervising bathrooms and recess areas to ensure social distancing



Touchless temperature checks at all entrances



Providing ventilation in classrooms and student spaces (e.g. Library)



Social distancing, including adequate spacing of desks and chairs



Developing, practicing, and enforcing routines



Handwashing stations throughout campus



Cleaning and disinfecting surfaces and materials as recommended and instructed by authorities



Antiseptic gel stations throughout campus and classrooms



Restricting individuals on campus to only students and essential school staff (parent meetings will be held online)



Requiring masks for everyone on campus



Controlled directional flow of movement of students



Students and Staff bringing snacks, lunch, and water from home



Prohibition of hugging, kissing and physical contact as greetings

We plan to open our campus in August!

Our intention is for all students at all levels to be able to ***return to campus 5 days per week.***

We are planning for this to happen, and we are excited about this. But we need patience to help us ensure the campus is safe with this many students.

These plans may be overturned by changes in the public health crisis and decisions made by SEP or the Health Department.

In order to open the campus for all students it is important to note the following, which are explained in better detail in this document:

- We are establishing a special 'Back to School' two week period from August 30 – September 10 in which only a few students will be on campus each day while we finalize safety protocols.
- We will be providing our DOLP 3.0 for all students who prefer to study from home. There will be no food services for the first few weeks at least. Students will bring their own food.
- There can be no parents on campus so that we can have maximum control to the potential exposure of COVID on campus.

Class Divisions / Management

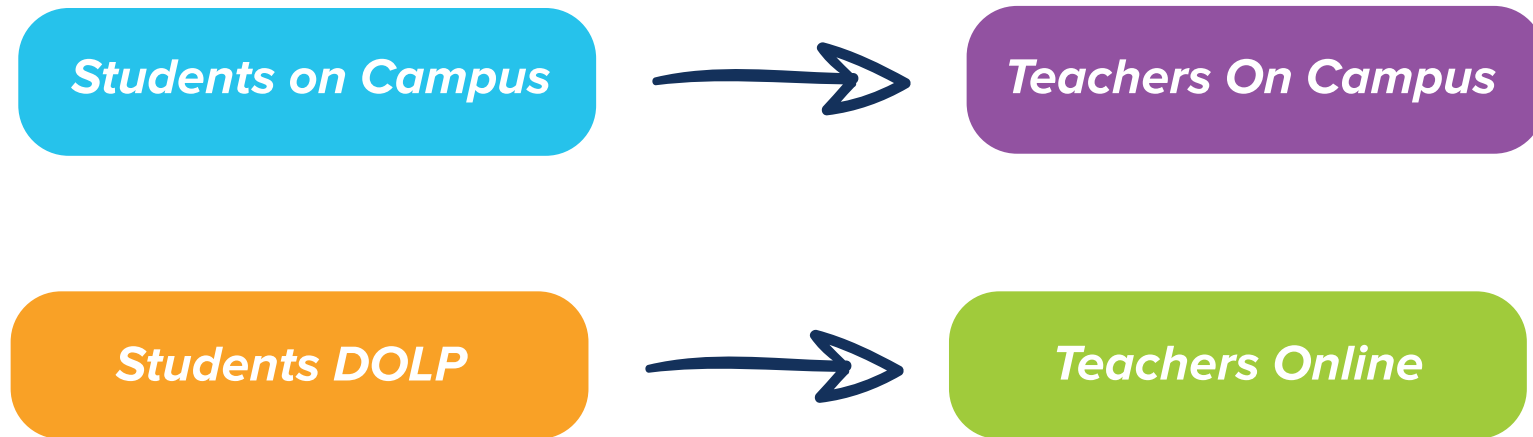
At some grade levels, students will be divided into two groups by last name to help us in the first two weeks. Details are shown in the charts for 'Back to School'

Adjustments may need to be made based on student numbers and more information will be provided closer to the reopening of campus.

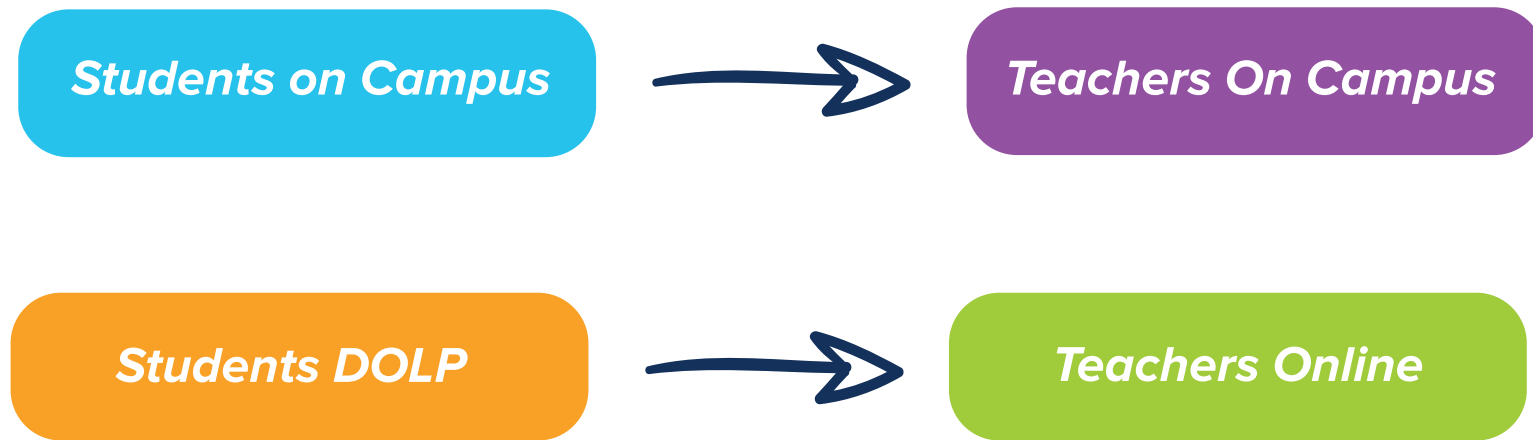


Pre-School

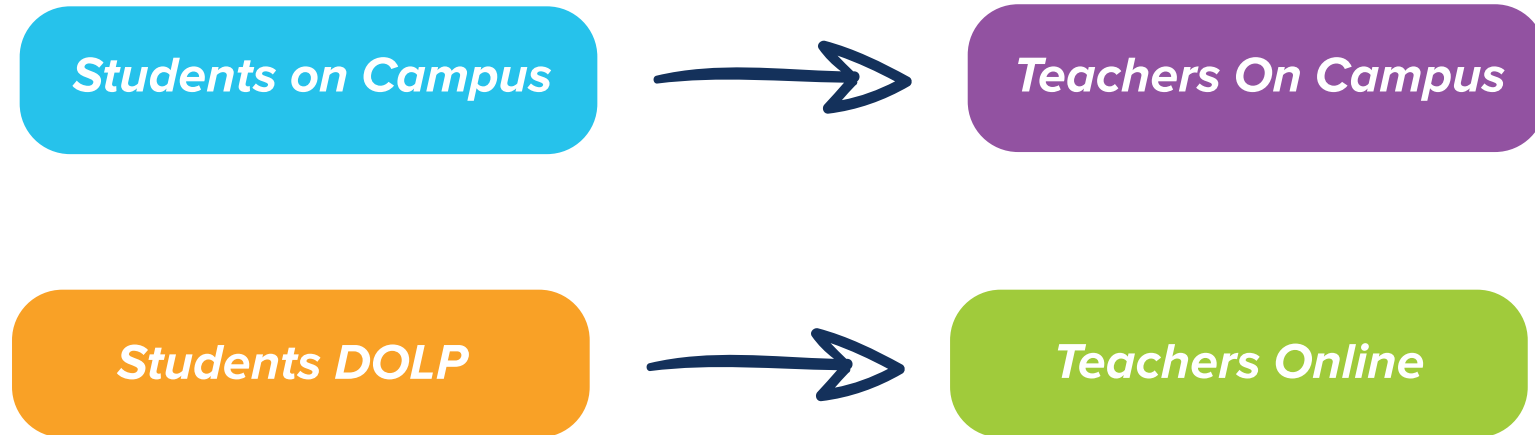
DOLP instruction

DOLP students online will attend live English, Spanish, Mathematics, Science, and Humanities classes; all other classes will be given asynchronously with one-to-one daily support in Study Hall and Office Hours.

Technology

Middle School requires all students to use their Chromebook device that is registered with our Technology department. DOLP students will also need use their cameras at all times they are in a live class.

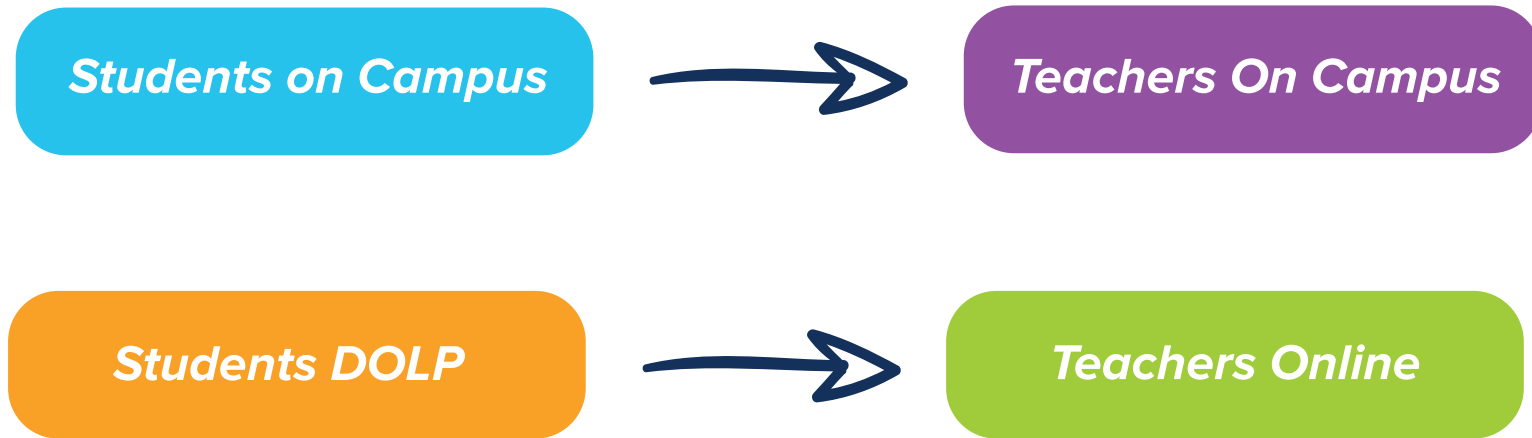
High School



All teachers will be on campus for in-person classes.

DOLP students will receive asynchronous instruction to cover all course content taught during the day, as well as support and feedback. There will also be live daily office help desks for DOLP students from 2.00 – 2.45pm

Protocols and Special Prevention Measures

Planning will ensure careful and minimal use of equipment and adequate social distancing during activities, using the full campus.

Our DOLP will continue for students studying from home.





Back to School **(August 30 – September 10)**

All grades and classes have a staggered entry for two weeks, our 'Back to School' period.

This provides the school the chance to monitor and learn from different arrangements of half and full classes, increasing grade levels at school, drop off and pick up schedules.

We consider this as an essential opportunity to ensure we can manage all students and staff safely for a full return in September. If any of the details provide a difficulty for families with more than one child please speak to your principal, we are here to help!

- 3.** As with all of our plans, these are subject to continued permission from the authorities to offer after school activities, and the continued health of our own campus and community.

Choosing the DOLP Option to study from home?

We will be offering our DOLP program for students who:

- Have chosen to register for the DOLP program by personal choice.
- Have tested positive for COVID and/or who have been confirmed by the school or their personal doctor as being at high level of suspicion for infection.

It is important to note that students are not able to switch from 'on campus' learning to DOLP classes on a daily basis or without prior consent. (A potential high risk for infection or a positive test result will be confirmed by a doctor and require a switch to DOLP for a minimum of 10 days).

This is because:

- Teachers plan activities based on an idea of how many students will be present.
- The DOLP program will not be totally aligned on a daily basis with in-person classes and therefore switching between the two will not make sense to the students.

In August all families will register for in-person or the DOLP program. An opportunity to switch from in-person back to DOLP will be offered approximately every month or trimester, depending on your section.
