We've had a summer "break" from our General meetings, but we've been busy!

Thank you to Janet Gardner for coordinating the 17 days of manning the Sac GOP Booth at the State Fair and to all of you who joined us during our SRWF Volunteer days. It was very exciting to see the enthusiasm of those flocking to our booth eager to get gear and ideas for the upcoming election.

Several of us attended the CFRW Summer Conference in Sacramento and as always got new information and ideas from others attending and heard great speakers. Congressman Tom McClintock gave an excellent presentation on what's at stake in the upcoming election, the contrast between what Republicans are offering vs. Democrats and why he is wholeheartedly recommending Donald J. Trump for President. He said - "When Donald Trump left office, our border was secure, the world was at peace, and America was energy independent for the first time in our lifetimes. Gasoline averaged \$2.39/gallon, inflation was 1.4%, and a 30 year mortgage cost 1.9%. We had won one of the largest tax cuts in American history and the biggest rollback of regulations. And before the lock down leftists took a wrecking ball to our lives, these policies produced the lowest unemployment rate in 50 years, the lowest poverty rate in 60 years and the fastest wage growth in 40 years."
