
Koisy Coin... For the month of November, our Noisy Coin offering will be split three ways with 1/3 going to the Kandiyohi County Food Shelf, 1/3 going to the Good Samaritan Fund of the Willmar Area Community Foundation, and 1/3 going to United Community Action Agency. The Noisy Coin will be counted each week and \$500 will be added to the total every week from Bethel's Community Outreach Fund for the five Sundays of November. For the third week of November, \$1,129.81 was sent to each of these entities for a total of \$3,389.43, plus \$1000 given specifically for the food shelf.
